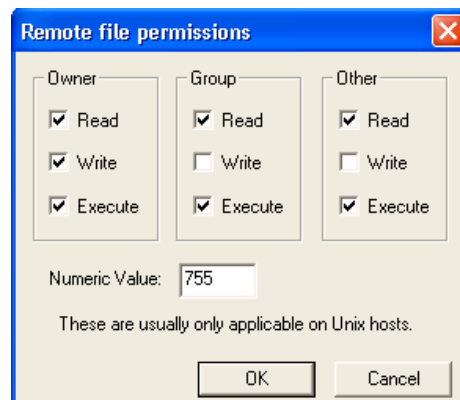


Student Account Login & Webpage Creation (via FTP)  
WSU, College of Engineering

1. From your PC's **Start** menu, select **Run** and type:  
“**telnet gigastar.eng.wayne.edu**”. When prompted, login using your assigned WSU accessID and password.
2. Run an FTP tool (e.g., [WS FTP program](#)) on your PC
3. Type in **webpages.eng.wayne.edu** as host name
4. Type in your WSU accessID for “user ID”
5. Type in your WSU password for “password”
6. Click on the CONNECT button
7. Now that you have accessed your student folder under the webpages server, you will need to create a directory named “public\_html” which is accomplished by clicking on the Mkdir button and typing **public\_html**
8. This is it! But let us make sure that the content of this folder is available for other users to view and execute. This is done by right clicking the mouse on the *public\_html* folder you have just created and choosing the CHMOD(UNIX) option. This will open the “remote file permissions” configuration window. Make sure that this window looks exactly like the sample shown below. Then, click **ok**.



You will need to create an “index.html” file inside the *public\_html* folder as your default webpage entry point. All other webpage related content must reside inside this folder, too. You may now browse the webpage you have created by pointing your web browser to: <http://webpages.eng.wayne.edu/~accessID/> (where *accessID* is your WSU login ID)
